Engage Actively: • Listen attentively. • Use the interviewer's name in conversation. • Be concise and clear in your responses. Avoid Common Pitfalls: • Don't speak negatively about previous employers. • Avoid checking your phone.

Send a Thank-You Email: • Express gratitude for the opportunity. • Reiterate your interest in the position. Reflect on the Interview:
